Membership: Membership is open to any man who indicates his desire to belong and to participate in the ministry of the church through United Methodist Men and who is willing to engage daily in Bible study and prayer, to bear witness to Christ's way in daily work and in all personal contacts through words and actions, and to engage in Christian service. clergy of the local church are ex officio members of the group and its executive committee.

Officers: The Methodist Men elect their own officers annually. The President is a member of the Administrative Board of the church.
